BIRD-FRIENDLY GLAZING and AODA HURDLES

This two-topic lunch and learn will provide attendees with important and timely information about bird-friendly glazing: why it is necessary, codes governing its use, products on the market, and considerations when using these products. We'll also get an update on the *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA)*, including a review of the year-end compliance report deadline, the new requirements kicking in on January 1, 2018, and medicinal marijuana in the workplace.

SPEAKERS: Our keynote speaker is **Michael Measure**, the Executive Director and Co-Founder of FLAP Canada (Fatal Light Awareness Program), the first organization in the world to address the issue of birds in collisions with buildings.

Steve Morren is the Director – Architectural Program at Walker Glass Company Ltd., and is an expert in the products and application of bird-friendly glazing in North America.

Jennifer Threndyle is WSPS's expert on AODA regulations. Jennifer works with companies across the province to ensure they are in compliance with a complex list of requirements.

All glazing contractors should be aware of the requirements and where they should be providing this specialty product. AODA has a new wave of requirements coming into effect at the end of 2017 with heavy fines for non-compliance. WSPS will bring you up to date on what they are and how you can safeguard your business.
