Please note: The Ministry of Natural Resources requires that all attendees have a valid fishing license. You cannot board the boats without a valid license. A temporary license will not be provided.

You need an Outdoors Card before you can buy license tags to fish in Ontario. To purchase an Outdoors Card and a fishing license, go to www.huntandfishontario.com. The Outdoors Card will cost \$8.57 + HST, and the fishing license will cost \$15.07 + HST for a one-year Conservation Tag for Ontario residents. Alternatively, you can get a one-day Sport Fishing Licence, which costs \$12.21 for Ontario residents and requires no Outdoors Card. Single-day tags are less expensive but could be wasted if the event must be rescheduled because of inclement weather.
